## **FIELD TEST FOR POPULATION & HOUSING CENSUS 2011**

In preparation for the 2011 Population and Housing Census of Jamaica, the Statistical Institute of Jamaica (STATIN) will be conducting a field test between June 28 and July 31, 2010. The aim of the exercise is to test the questionnaire design and wording as well as the interviewer's instruction manuals. Interviewers will visit a sample of households in all parishes to administer two (2) questionnaires. One questionnaire is designed to collect information on the household and the other questionnaire will be administered to every individual in the household. Any responsible adult member of the household may provide the information.

**The specific areas to be visited in each parish are listed below:**

- **Kingston- Manley Meadows, Camperdown Road, Rollington Town, Fernandez Road**
- **St Andrew- Ashley Road, Metcalf Road, Waterhouse, Burke Road, Waterhouse, Diamond Road, Spanish Town Road, Penwood Road, Content, Flamstead, Mavis Bank**
- **St Thomas - Soho, Top York, Seaforth, Bath, Plantain Garden, Lion Park**
- **Portland - Buff Bay, Lynch Ave, Russell Ave (Port Antonio), Nonsuch, Turtle Crawl, Sherwood Forest**
- **St Mary- Jack's River, Mason Hall, Grant's Town, Grays Inn, Fort George**
- **St Ann - Parry Town, Milford, Alexandria, Armadale**
- **Trelawny - Duncans, Warsop**
- **St James - Paradise Norwood, Plum-Mt Horeb**
- **Hanover- Cold Spring, Lucea**
- **Westmoreland- Gratto-Darliston; Hudson Street- Savanna la Mar**
- **St Elizabeth - Tryall, Junction, Thornton, Siloah**
- **Manchester-Mandeville, Gutters, Spur Tree**
- **Clarendon- Jericho, Glenmuir**
- **St Catherine - Bog Walk, Berkshire Hall, Greater Portmore (Chedwin near Kensington)**

The areas have been randomly selected from the complete list of all enumeration areas in Jamaica, which STATIN maintains.

All staff members of STATIN are equipped with proper identification and must present this at all times. The public is reminded that, in accordance to the Statistics Act all information collected by STATIN must be kept in the strictest of confidence.
