

August 2001

The August Consumer Price Index Bulletin released by the Statistical Institute of Jamaica reveals that the All Jamaica "All Group" Consumer Price Index for August 2001 was 1430.9 an increase of 0.9 per cent. This compares with 1.0 per cent for July and 1.7 per cent for June.

The rate of inflation for the period August 2000 to August 2001 is 7.1 per cent a 1.1 percentage point below the 8.2 per cent for the corresponding period in 2000.

A look at the regional indices shows increases for all three regions "Kingston Metropolitan Area 0.8 per cent "Other Towns 1.2 per cent and 'Rural Areas' 0.7 per cent. For the month of August all the groups recorded higher indices than in July except 'Transportation'. The index for the group 'Miscellaneous Expenses' showed a 1.5 per cent increase, due to the increase in cinema fares and school supplies.
