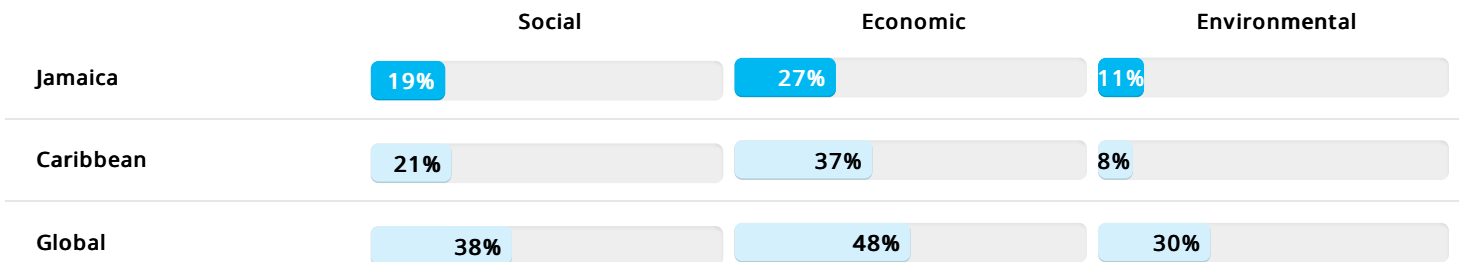

SUMMARY

Jamaica ranks 164 in the Open Data Inventory 2016 with an overall score of 18%. The overall score is a combination of a data coverage subscore of 19% and a data openness subscore of 18%.

Jamaica scores higher than the regional median for environmental statistics. Within the country, the highest levels of coverage and openness are on economic statistics and the lowest levels are on environmental statistics.

RECOMMENDATIONS

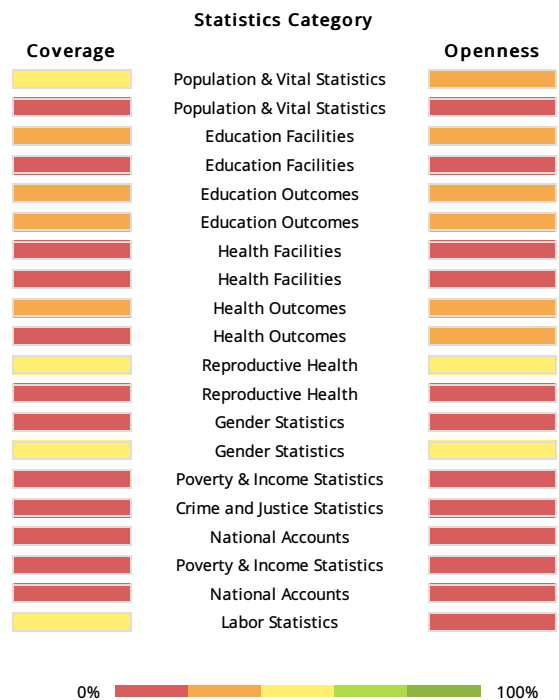
Coverage

- Collect and publish more disaggregated data across all data categories.

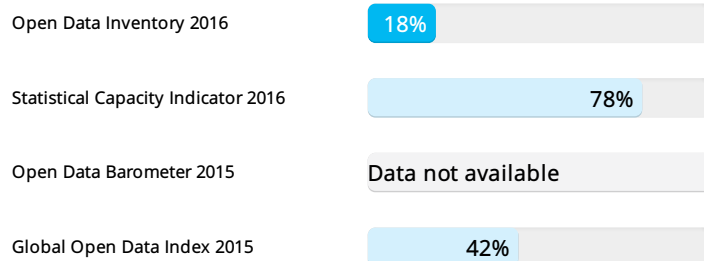
Openness

- Create a clear and open terms of use policy, such as CC BY 4.0, for all websites publishing official statistics.
- Publish more data in machine readable and non-proprietary formats such as XLSX, CSV or JSON.
